# PROPERTY ASSESSMENT AMENDMENT LAW, 2019

## WHEREAS:

- A. Pursuant to section 5 of the *First Nations Fiscal Management Act*, the council of a first nation may make laws respecting taxation for local purposes of reserve lands and interests in reserve lands; and,
- B. The Council of Ts'uubaa-asatx, formerly known as Lake Cowichan First Nation, wishes to amend the Ts'uubaa-asatx Property Assessment Law, 2020 as set out in this amending law

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Ts'uubaa-asatx hereby enacts as follows

## Citation

1. This Law may be cited as Ts'uubaa-asatx Property Assessment Amendment Law, 2019.
