**Paul First Nation
Band Council Resolution
2017 Tax Rates**

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to such purpose; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Paul Band enacted the *Wabamun Indian Reserve Property Taxation By-law* on February 26, 1973;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following by-law is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act* and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.


Pursuant to section 51 of the *Wabamun Indian Reserve Property Taxation By-law*, the 2017 tax rates to be applied against the assessed value of property shall be:


