## BY-LAW NO. 1.85

To revoke all previous By-Laws.

WHEREAS Section 85.1 of the Indian Act (Revised June 28, 1985) empowers the Council of a band to make By-Laws respecting the regulation of Intoxicants on an Indian Reserve.

WHEREAS the Council of the .Stony Rapids... Band of Indians wishes to provide regulations for the control of intoxicants on the reserve consistant with the requirements as outlined in Section 85(1) of the Indian Act (Revised June 28,1985).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Stony Rapids ... Band of Indians enacts as a By-Law the following.

In this By-Law

- 1. Council means the Council of the Stony Rapids .... Band of Indians.
- 2. Reserve means Chicken Indian Reserve. #227
- 3. The Council of the Stony Rapids Band of Indians hereby revokes all previous By-Laws made to control intoxicants on the following Indian Reserves: Chicken Indian Reserve #227
