DO HEREBY RESOLVE: The Council of Pic Robert Band of Indians at a meeting held on Sept 9th, 1968 makes the following by*law pursuant to paragraphs(e) (r) of the Section 80 of the Indian Act, by-Law No. 5

(a) That all dogs be kept tied on the Reserve, not to let running at large on the Reserve, the owner of any dog running at large on the Reserve will be warned twice, If the owner does not tie his or her dog after the second warning the dog will be destroyed,

(b) A owner found guilty of violating the provisions of paragraph (a) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable for the provisions for the fees and services of the person appointed by the Band Council to have the dog destroyed
