

BY-LAW

For a by-law regulating traffic on the Jocko Point Access Road.

WHEREAS the Council of the Nipissing Band of Indians were petitioned to enact a speed limit by members of the Nipissing Indian Band residing along the access Road leading to the Jocko Point Sub-division from Highway No.17;

And WHEREAS the Council of the Nipissing Band of Indians deem it to be necessary and to the best interests of the residents along the Access Road to the Jocko Point Sub-division;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Nipissing Band of Indians enacts under Section 80 subsections (b) and (r) of the Indian Act as a by-law thereof the following;

1. That a maximum speed of THIRTY (30) MILES PER HOUR be allowed on the Access Road to the Jocko Point Subdivision being that part of the Road leading from Highway No.17 to the point where the Access Road joins the Jocko Point Subdivision Road at Lot No. 1 of the Jocko Point Subdivision.
2. Any person who violates any provision of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS nor more than ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS or a prison term not exceeding TEN DAYS or both a fine and imprisonment.
