Miplusing Aund of Indians

Py-law No. 7- 73.

Being a by-law to control vandalism of Band owned property of the Nipissing Indian Band.

WHENCAS the Council of the Nipissing Indian Band have witnessed an increase in property vandalized by unknown persons,

A ND WHEREAS the Council of the Nipissing Indian Band have found the cost of repairs caused by vandalism to be unwarranted and borne by the funds of the entire population of the Nipissing Band;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Nipissing Indian Band deem it to be necessary and to the best interests of residents of the Nipissing Indian Band;

NCW THEREFORE the Council of Nipissing Indian Band enacts under Section 81 subsection (q) of the Indian Act as a by-law thereof;

- 1. That any person or persons other than a person or persons of juvenile age be held financially responsible for any and all damages caused by that person or persons to any property owned by the Nipissing Indian Band and;
- 2. further that any and all damages caused by person or persons of juvenile age be the financial responsibility of parents or parent or guardian(s) of the person or persons causing any acts of vandalism to property comed by the Nipissing Indian Band.
- 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ty-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Bollars or a prison term not exceeding Ten Days (10) or both a fine out import inscent.
