

WASHAGAMIS BAY BAND OF INDIANS.

By-law number: - 2 -.

A By-law to provide for the appointment of By-law enforcement officers.

1. WHEREAS Clause q of Section 81 of The Indian Act empowers the Council of Washagamis Bay Band to make by-laws with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to the exercise of the powers of the said Council under the said Section.

2. AND WHEREAS on the 3rd day of April 1979 the said Council passed a By-law to regulate traffic on Rat Portage Indian Reserve 38A.

3. NOW THEREFOR BE IT ENACTED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, by the Council of Washagamis Bay Band as follows:

4. The Council of Washagamis Bay Band may at any time and from time to time by Band Council Resolution appoint any member or members of Washagamis Bay Band to enforce any by-law or by-laws of the said Council upon such terms and conditions and for such remuneration as may be settled in advance by the said Council with Department of Indian and Northern Affairs: and the said Council may at any time and from time to time and without attributing any reason therefor terminate any such appointment.
