

The Council of the Pic Heron Bay Band of Indians at a meeting held Aug. 15, 1965, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 4

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Pic River No. 50 Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of twenty-five miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the Pic River No. 50 Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the Council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
- (d) With the coming into force of this by-law, by-law No. 1 made at a meeting held July 2, 1961, shall cease to be in force.
