

BY-LAW NO. 7

A by-law to regulate the operation of motor vehicles on Long Lake Reserve #58.

Now therefore the Council of the Long Lake #58 Band of Indians hereby enacts as a by-law thereof as follows:

- (a) No person shall operate a car, truck, bus, skidoo or any other motorised vehicle on Long Lake #58 Reserve roads unless he or she is in possession of a current drivers licence issued by the Province of Ontario, and qualifying the person to operate the type and class of motor vehicle involved.
- (b) No person shall operate a car, truck, bus, skidoo or any other vehicle on Long Lake #58 Reserve roads unless such person has insurance coverage issued by a registered Insurance Company. Such insurance must cover public liability and personal injury up to an amount no less than \$200,000.00 and be generally in accordance with the insurance requirements of the Province of Ontario for the operation of a motor vehicle on the provincial highway and road networks.
- (c) Any person found guilty of a violation of any provision of this by-law is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or both fine and imprisonment in accordance with Section 81 of the Indian Act R.S., c149, s.1
