

The Council of the Walpole Island Band  
of Indians at a meeting held Tuesday February 2, 1954  
makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (d) and (r)  
of section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 3

A by-law to provide for the regulation of the  
carrying of firearms, B.B. guns and air-rifles by minors in  
the Walpole Island Indian Reserve in the Province of Ontario.

(a) No boy or girl on the Walpole Island Indian Reserve  
actually or apparently under the age of 16 years, shall carry  
firearms, B.B. guns or air-rifles or use the same, within the  
reserve, unless accompanied by his or her parent or some res-  
ponsible person of the full age of 21 years.

(b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this  
by-law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on  
summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or  
to imprisonment not exceeding seven days, or to both fine  
and imprisonment.
