DO HEREBY RESOLVE: BYLAW NO. 18

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the preservation, protection and management of fur-bearing animals, fish and other game on the Reserve and for the protection of property.

BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of the Walpole Island Band of Indians, as follows:-

1. No fire of any kind shall be set in marsh areas on the Walpole Island Indian Reserve or in any portion thereof where same may spread to grass or vegetation of any kind so as to endanger fur-bearing animals, fish or other game of any type.
2. No fire shall be set in or near any marsh area on Walpole Island Indian Reserve under any circumstances, without first obtaining a Permit therefor from the Administrator of Walpole Island Band of Indians.
3. Any permit obtained under the terms hereof shall be obtained on written application, setting out date and time when fire is to be set, exact location of fire, precautions to be taken to prevent spread of fire, and names of persons who will be in attendance until fire is burned out or extinguished.
4. No Permit shall be issued by the Administrator unless and until proper precautions are assured in connection with such application, and the terms of the application shall be observed by the applicant.
5. Save as permitted under any Permit issued under the terms of this By-law, no fire for the disposal of rubbish or waste material of any kind shall be set within 100 feet of any building or except in a cleared area of sufficient extent to prevent spread thereof, or in a container to prevent spread thereof, and no Permit shall be required for any fire set under the terms of this clause.
6. Any person guilty of an infraction of this By-law or any of the terms thereof, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or to imprisonment for a term, not exceeding thirty (30) days, or to both fine and imprisonment.

PASSED AND ENACTED as a By-law of the Walpole Island Band of Indians this 14th day of August A.D. 1967.
