

 Indian Agency, in the Province of ONTARIO
 at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the
 Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 5th day
 of JUNE, A.D. 19 52, in the presence of the Indian
 Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of
 Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of

 SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE BE BANNED FROM ANY PUBLIC DANCES

 80 OF INDIAN ACT. MOVED BY DOMINIC DAY SECONDED BY
 ALEX MEAWASIGE - CARRIED.
