



MARIE**Indian Agency, in the Province of ONTARIO**at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the**Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 5th day**of JUNE, A.D. 1952, in the presence of the Indian**Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of**Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;**Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of*
