DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS Shawanaga First Nation By-Law No. 17:176, Registration No. SOR/76/569, provides for the regulation of traffic, law and order, local works, trespassing, and penalty.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Shawanaga First Nation did enact By-Law No. 17:176 on the 7 day of September, 1976.

AND WHEREAS the Government of Shawanaga deems it to be expedient and in the best interests of the residents of Shawanaga First Nation to amend the said by-law. The said the said by-law. with the town to

NOW THEREFURE Section 5.2 (a) of By-Law No. 17:176 is amended by striking out the words "twenty five (25) kilometres an hour" where they appear therein and substituting therefor the words "forty (40) kilometres an hour", so that Section 5.2 (a) now reads:
