PAGE ONE OF TWO:

WHEREAS Shawanaga Band By-law No. 17:176, dated September 7, 1976, Registration No. SOR/76/569 provides for the regulation of traffic, law and order, local works, trespassing, and penalty;

AND WHEREAS Band Council Resolution #379, dated August 5, 1981, amended s.5 of By-law No. 17:176 by deleting the words "30 miles per hour" and substituting the words "50 kilometres per hour" so that it now reads "No person shall operate a vehicle on a road at a rate of speed in excess of fifty (50) kilometres per hour";

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- S.5 of By-law No. 17:176 as amended by Band Council Resolution #379, dated August 5, 1981, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:
- 5.0 Effective May 15, 1995, use of the Shawanaga First Nation Road shall be governed in accordance with the following:
- 5.1 All persons who use the Shawanaga First Nation Road shall obey all traffic signs including, for greater certainty, all stop signs, speed limit signs and school signs.
- 5.2 No person shall operate a vehicle on Shawanaga First Nation Road in Shawanaga Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of:
 - a) twenty-five (25) kilometres an hour in the Village Core Area, as shown on the map in Schedule A attached; or
 - b) fifty (50) kilometres an hour in any part of the Shawanaga Reserve which is outside the Village Core Area.

- 5.3 Except in an emergency, a person who is not a band member shall not stop their vehicle on the Shawanaga First Nation Road.
- 5.4 No person who is not a band member shall hunt or discharge a firearm from, near, on, or along the Shawanaga First Nation Road.
- 5.5 Persons who violate this By-law are liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both.
