

## REPEALING BY-LAW

### By-Law No. 1 RESPECTING THE REGULATION OF CURFEW SAUGEEN INDIAN RESERVE No. 29.

**WHEREAS** section 81, paragraphs, (c), (d), and (r), of section 81 of the Indian act empowers the Council of a Band of Indians to pass By-Laws to provide for the observance of law and order, the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances, and the imposition of a penalty for the violation of any such by-law;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Saugeen Indian Reserve # 29, did enact By-Law No. 1 on the 7th day of January 1957, pursuant to paragraphs 81 (c), (d), and (r), of the Indian Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the said Council is of the opinion that such By-Law is not required at this time;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Saugeen Indian Reserve # 29, enacts as a By-Law thereof the following;

By-Law No. **1996.1** enacted on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 1996 and being a By-Law Respecting Curfew on the Saugeen Indian Reserve # 29 be and the same is hereby repealed.

## **CURFEW BY-LAW**

A By-Law to provide for the regulation of activities of boys and girls on the Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29, actually and apparently under 16 years of age.

### **Definitions:**

**"Council"** means the Band Council as described by the Indian Act and means the Council of the Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29, for the purpose of this By-Law.

**"Police Committee"** means a group of Band Members appointed by the Council of the Band for the protection of the children for the purpose of this by-law.

**"Band Members"** means a person whose name appears on the Saugeen Indian Reserve Band List in accordance to Section 8 of the Indian Act.

**"Holidays and Weekends"** includes Fridays and Saturdays, and any other scheduled school holidays for the purpose of this By-Law.

**"By-Law Officer"** means a person appointed by the Council of the Band to carry out the terms of this By-Law, This person (s) may also be a Police Officer.

**"Police Officer"** means officers of the law as prescribed by the Indian Act and means the Anishinabek Police Services for the purpose of this By-Law.

Section

- a) No boy or girl on the Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29 actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall loiter any place within the Indian Reserve after;  
11:00 p.m. in the afternoon during school holidays and weekends;  
10:00 p.m. in the afternoon during school days;
- b) No boy or girl on the Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29. actually or apparently under 16 years of age, shall be in any place of entertainment, lane, by-way or common area within the said Reserve after the hour of 10:00 p.m. unless accompanied by his or her parent or an adult appointed by the parent to accompany such child.
- c) A boy or girl on the Saugeen Indian Reserve No. 29. found violating provisions of paragraphs (a) or (b) may be warned and conducted home or to a place of safety by a Police Officer or a By-Law Officer and if the warning is not regarded, or after the warning the boy or girl is again found disobeying said paragraphs (a) or (b), the parents of such boy or girl shall be directed to meet with the Police Committee appointed by the Council of the Band for the protection of the children.
- d) A parent who permits his child to violate paragraphs (a) or (b) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a minimum fine of \$50.00 and not exceeding \$200.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days.


