To enact:

A By-Law for the protection, preservation and management of Migratory Game Birds on the St. Regis Indian Reserve No. 15 in the Province of Quebec 8 Ontario made under authority of the Indian Act, Section 80 (0) 8 (r).

- 1. (a) No person other than a member of the Iroquois of St. Regis Band of Indiano shall hunt migratory game birds within the boundaries of the above mentioned Reserves without a permit issued by authority of the Council of the Band.
 - (b) The Council of the Band shall appoint permit issuers.
 - (c) No member of the St. Regis Band shall accompany any person, who is not a member of the Band, onto the above mentioned Reserves, for the purpose of hunting migratory game birds, unless that person has first obtained a permit to dos.so.
 - (d) All non-members of the Band, to qualify for a permit to hunt on the above mentioned Reserves, must be in possession of a valid and subsisting Provincial hunting license and a Federa Migratory Game Bird Hunting Permit and present these to the issuer when applying for a permit to hunt on the said Reserv subject to
 - (i) when hunting on Cornwall Island Indian Reserve No. 59. the applicant must possess a Province of Ontario hunting license.
 - (ii) when hunting on St. Regis Reserve No.15, the applicant must possess a Province of Quebec hunting license. continue.....
