The L missauges of the Credit Council at a meeting held this 20th day of November 1961 make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (c) and paragraph (p) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law 80.---

1

A by-law governing the preservation of Game and Wildlife.

- 1. He person shall take, trap, shoot or otherwise destroy any deer on this Reserve at any time except during the open sesson which shall be set each year by the Rississauges of the Credit council.
- 2. He person shall shoot or otherwise destroy pheasants on this Reserve of each time except during the open sesson which shall be set each year by the Mississaugus of the Credit council.
- 5. He person shall hust with or shoot on the Reserve at any time with a rifle larger than a fit calibre, regardless of whether such person may be licensed to use a high powered rifle off the Reserve or not, but a person may hunt with or shoot a shotgun on the Reserve.
- 4. So person thall arrange or organize any driven or builting parties at may time, whereby deer or channels will be driven by a group of becters out of shelter and destroyed.
- 5. No person shall trap, mere or shoot Makrat at any time except during the season which shall be set and announced by the council each year or to dig into or destroy any Muskrat house, burrow or nest at any time whatspayer.
- 5. That a bounty on force and solves may be set and paid each year by the council as conditions may require, to keep them under control.
- 7. No person except a member and resident of the Mississaugae of the Crett
  Reserve may hant on the Mississaugas of the Crett Reserve.
- 8. Any person found guilty of a breach of any of the above regulations shall upon conviction before a Magistrate or Justice, be subject to a fine of act less than (\$ 10.00) ten dollars and not more than (\$100.00) one hundred dollars plus costs, or to a term in prisonment not exceeding thirty days, or both.
