

HIAWATHA INDIAN RESERVE

Amendment By-Law Number 10-1 (1979)

The Council of the Hiawatha Band of Indians at a meeting held on the Hiawatha Reserve makes the following By-Law pursuant to Paragraphs 'B' and 'R' of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

By-Law No. 10-1

A By-Law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Hiawatha Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 50 kilometers an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) We hereby authorize stop signs to be located at the intersection of Paudash Street and County Road No. 31, so that all vehicles must come to a stop at this location. Sketch attached indicating the location of these signs.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of the By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable of summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
- (d) Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council this 17th day of July 1979.


