HIAWATHA INDIAN RESERVE

BY LAW NUMBER 10

The Council of the Hiawatha Indian Band of Indians at a meeting held on the Hiawatha Reserve makes the following By-Law pursuant to Paragraphs "B" and "R" of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

By-Law Number 10

A By-Law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Hiawatha Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 50 kilometers an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
- (c) Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council this 23'rd day of May, 1978.
