The Council of the GArden River Land of Indians at a meeting held this third (5) day of April 1976, made the following by-law oursuant to paragraph (b) and paragraph (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

BY-LAW NO. 7

1

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Indian Reserve, in the province of Ontario.

- 1. In this by-law
 - (a) " Council " means the Council of the Garden
 River Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Reserve " means the Garden River Indian Reserve:
 - (c) "residential area" menas any area in the

 Reserve designated in writing by the Council

 as a residential area for the purposesof

 this by-law; and
 - (d) "vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor car, motor truck, trailer, snow mobile, motorcycle, traction engine, tractor, roadmaking machinery or other conveyance that is driven, propelled or drawn by any kind of power.
- 2. No vehicle shall be operated on the Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of 40 miles per hour as posted.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 hereof, no vehicle shall be quieted in any residential area at a rate of speed is covers of 10 miles on hear and any place posted. (Red : Boad, Boop Read, rall back read, 20 takes per hear) (Felio Rater Boad, Jan Con Black back, 10 tiles per hear) (The Sub-division Boad is no to be also per hear)
- 4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be quilty of an elfence and all lac little on the my or latter to

a fine not exceeding \$100.00, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and Imprisonment. The fines that are to be charged are as follows...l-10 over the speed limit...\$2.00 per mile 11-20 over the speed limit...\$3.00 per mile 21-30 over the speed limit...\$5.00 per mile.
