The Council of the Cape Croker Band of Indians at a neeting held on June 26, 1967, makes the following By-law pursuant to paragraph (B) and (R) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. &

A By-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Cape Croker Park, Cape Croker Indian Reserve, in the Province of Contario.

(a) That no car (vehicle) will be allowed in the Cape Croker Park unless said car is covered by permit purchased from Park Authority.

Any person who violates this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on surmary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or to both fine and imprisonment.
