TRAFFIC BY-LAW

The Brunswick House Band Traffic By-Law

Whereas, Sections 81 (1) (b), (c), (q) and (r) of the Indian Act empowers the Council of a Band to make by-laws for the regulation of traffic, any ancillary matters and the imposition of a penalty for the violation of the by-law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Brunswick House Band enacts as a by-law as follows:

- No person shall operate any vehicle in excess of 25km/hr in the residential area of the Brunswick House Reserve # 76B, commonly known as Duck Lake.
- No person shall operate any vehicle in a manner dangerous to public safety or to propery, in the residential area of the Brunswick House Reserve # 76B, commonly known as Duck Lake.
- Any person who is suspected of breaking this by-law may be given a warning by the police.
- Any person who violates this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction;
 - for a first offence, to a prohibition from driving on Brunswick House Reserve # 76B, for a period of up to three months; and
 - for a subsequent offence, a fine of up to \$500.00 or imprisonment of up to $15\ \mathrm{days}$ or both.
