GENE A. BANNON JUSTICE OF THE PEACE IN & FOR THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

- *** <u>A BY LAW TO CONTROL DOGS WITHIN THE AREA OF THE ROCKY BAY RESERVE</u> *** The Chief and Band Council enacts as follows;
- 1. Any dogs known to have rabies shall be destroyed immediately and the remains burned.
- 2. Any dog suspected of having rabies shall be tied for a period of 14 days. The Ministry of Natural Resources or the Ontario Provincial Police shall be advised forthwith.
- Any dog running at large on the reserve and not being tied up by the owner, (shall/may)be destroyed.
- 4. Any dog or dogs in a pack, running at large within the area of the Public School or in any area of the reserve and where children may be placed in jeopardy (shall/may) be destroyed forthwith.
- 5. Every Band Member, being a resident at Rocky Bay Reserve and being the owner of a dog, shall have that dog tied up at all times.
- 6. Every Band Member, being a resident of Rocky Bay Reserve and being the the owner of a dog, found in contravention of this by-law and which has been seized may apply to the Chief (and/or) Band Council, and show cause, why such dog should not be destroyed.
 - (a) Nothing in section 6 places any responsibility on the Chief and/or Band Council for notifying a dog owner when a dog has been seized, and destroyed, the owner of the said dog shall be deemed responsible.
- 7. The Chief and Band Council may appoint one or several members of the Band to enforce this by-law and such persons may act singly or collectively when enforcing this by-law.
- THIS BY-LAW SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THE BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTION.
