

BY-LAW

"That we, the Beausoleil Band Council, rescind By-Law #5 ("Regulation of Traffic") and enact the following in its stead:

"The Council of the Beausoleil Band of Indians at a meeting held in the Council Board Room on Christian Island on November 21, 1977, make the following By-Law pursuant to Section 80, paragraph (b) and (r) of the Indian Act."

By-Law #5 "A By-Law to provide for the regulation of traffic on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30, in the Province of Ontario":

1. (a) The following regulations shall apply to all approved roadways, unassumed roads and all trails on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30.
(b) Vehicle shall be defined as all motorized vehicles, including automobiles, trucks, dune buggies, motorcycles, trail bikes, mini-bikes, and all motorized snowmobiles.
(c) Insurance will be the minimum requirements as regulated by the Province of Ontario.
(d) License will be as that required for vehicles and operators of such vehicles as required and regulated by the Province of Ontario.
2. No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 40 km/h (25 m.p.h.) within any residential area designated as such, now and at any later date.
3. No vehicle shall be operated on any beach area within Christian Island Indian Reserve #30.
4. No vehicle shall be operated on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30, which is not properly licensed and insured.
5. No vehicle shall be operated on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30 by any person not properly licensed or disqualified from operating a vehicle for any reason.
6. No vehicle shall be operated on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30, which in the opinion of any police officer in an unsafe state of repair. Such vehicle can be seized, immobilized and caused to be removed from Christian Island Indian Reserve #30, at the owner's expense. Said vehicle will be disallowed from returning until such time as satisfactory proof of its safety is obtained and presented to the police officer.
7. If in the opinion of any police officer a vehicle is being operated in a manner dangerous to the safety and property of the public, the operator/owner may be charged accordingly.
8. All other laws and regulations of the Province of Ontario and Canada in respect to the operation of a motor vehicle shall apply on Christian Island Indian Reserve #30.
9. Any person who violates any provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction of a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment."
