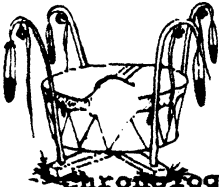

By-law No 2-00-B Respecting the Prohibition of Littering The Wauzhushk Onigum Nation

WHEREAS: The Council of Wauzhushk Onigum Nation desires to make a by-law for the prohibition of littering with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to the exercise of powers under section 81 of the Indian Act and for the imposition of a penalty for a violation thereof;

WHEREAS: The Council of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation is empowered to make such a by-law pursuant to paragraph 81 (1), (a), (d), (q), and (r) of the Indian Act;

AND WHEREAS: It is considered to be expedient and necessary for the health of the residents, the prevention of diseases and nuisances and for the overall appearance of the Reserve to provide for the prohibiting of littering on the Reserve;

AND WHEREAS: The Council of Wauzhushk Onigum Nation did enact By-law # 2-00 on September 19th, 2000, and By-law #2-00-A on October 31st, 200, and wishes to repeal the said By-laws and replace them with this bylaw 2-00-B.

NOW THEREFORE: The Council of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation hereby makes the following by-law.

Short Title

- This by-law may be cited as the "Littering Control By-Law".

Interpretation

- In this By-law,

"Band" means Wauzhushk Onigum Nation;
 "Council" means the Council of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation;
 "Litter" includes but is not limited to garbage, landfill, scraps of all kinds and any combination of thereof, left or abandoned on the Reserve in contravention of this By-law and littering has a corresponding meaning.

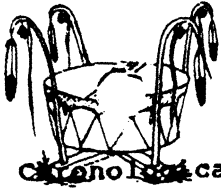

"Reserve" means the reserve set apart for the use and benefit of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation and include the Band's reserve No.38B.

Littering Prohibited

3. Subject to paragraph 4, no person shall abandon any litter on the Reserve.

Enforcement

4. A resident member of the Band may abandon litter on the Reserve only in a place, receptacle or area approved by the Council for receiving such litter.

Penalty

5. Every person who fails or refuses to comply with a provision of this by-law commits an offence.

General


- 6. A person who commits an offence under this by-law is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both.
- 7. Should a court determine that a provision of this by-law is invalid for any reason, the provision shall be severed from the by-law and the validity of the rest of the by-law shall not be affected.
- 8. This by-law comes into force 40 days after the date of mailing to the Minister of Indian and Northern Development as required pursuant to section 82 of the Indian Act.
- 9. The provisions of this by-law apply to all lands of the Reserve of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation.
- 10. This by-law is subject to the Indian Reserve Waste Disposal Regulations, C.R.C. 1978, c. 960.

Repeal

By-law #2-00 and 2-00-A being By-laws Respecting the Prohibition of Littering are hereby repealed.

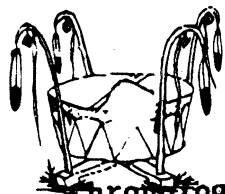



This by-law is hereby made at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Wauzhushk Onigum Nation this Friday of December 22nd, 2000.






