DO HEREEV RESOLVE: The Council of the Golden Lake Band of Indians at a meeting held at Golden Lake Indian Reserve on May 17th, 1972, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (a) and (h) of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

## Se-law No. 6

A by-law to control the use of buildings unfit for human habitation because of health and safety conditions.

Council to determine those buildings unsuitable and to request that they be inspected by the Renfrew County and District Health Unit and if the structure is unsuitable the Health Unit is to place a sign or placard on the entrance of vecant buildings stating that it is unfit for human habitation.

Council will then advise the owner by Registered Letter that they must make suitable renovations or tear down the building within six months, or Council will have the right to destroy or danolish the condemned building without compensation to the owner.
