Regulation of traffic

The Council of the Golden Lake Band of Indians at a meeting held on July second makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

By-law No. 2

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Golden Lake Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of Thirty miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the council of the band.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the Golden Lake Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the council of the band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
