

KAMLOOPS INDIAN BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTION

DATE APPROVED AT COUNCIL MEETING: March 24,1987

QUORUM:

The Kamloops Indian Bana Council does hereby resolve that:

WHEREAS the <u>Indian Act</u> R.S., c.I-6, as amended by 1985, c.27, provides that the council of a Band may make by-laws for the purpose of bringing sub-section 10(3) of the said Act into effect in respect of the Band;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as by-law of the Kamloops Indian Band as follows:

1. That Section 10(3) of the Indian Act, R.S., c.I-16, as amended by 1385 c.27, be and the same is hereby declared to be in effect with respect to the Kamloops Indian Band. Accordingly, the consents required for the Band to assume control of its own membership shall be given by a majority of the members of the Band who are of the full age of 18 years.
