DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

that we do make the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

Bylaw No. 6

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in Masset Indian Reserve No. 1, in the Province of British Columbia.

- (a) No vehicle shall be parked at any time for a period in excess of fifteen minutes on the north side of the Provincial Highway within the village limits, the easterly boundary of the village being the 15 mile per hour sign where the houses begin.
- (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
