WHEREAS: the Indian Act provides that the Council of a Band may make by-laws for any or all of the following purposes, namely:

the construction and maintenance of water courses, roads, bridges, ditches, fences and other local works;

the regulation of the construction, repairs and use of buildings, whether owned by the band or by individual members of the band;

the construction and regulation of the use of public wells, cisterns, reservoirs and other regulated fire and safety.

WHEREAS: it is deemed to be beneficial for the general welfare of the community enacts as a by-law the following:

1. SHORT TITLE

This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Gitwinksihlkw Band of Indians Fire Safety By-law.

2. REPEAL OF EXISTING BY-LAWS

The following Band By-laws are hereby repealed in their entireties.

3. DEFINITIONS

The following terms, whenever used in this by-law or in any resolution of the Council dealing with this by-law, shall have the meaning respectively ascribed to them in this section unless the context otherwise requires:

"Act" means the Indian Act, Chapter 1-6 (1970) R.S.C. and the amendments thereto.

"Band" means the Council of the Band pursuant to the Act.

"Fire Safety Officer" means the person appointed by the Band Council on the recommendation of the Band Fire Safety Councillor to administer and enforce this by-law.
