THE KINCOLITH BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NUMBER 3

Being a BY-LAW for Elementary and Secondary Students.

The Council of the Kincolith Band of Indians at a meeting held at Kincolith on the Seventh day of April, 1988 makes the following By-law pursuant to paragraph (c), (d), (q), and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

A By-law to provide for the regulations of the activities of boys and girls on the Kincolith Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age or Grade 7 down.

- (a) No boy or girl on the Kincolith Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age or under grade 7 down shall loiter any place within the said Indian Reserve afer eight o'clock in the afternoon during week days unless there is a special event happening which helps benefit support for our reserve and nine o'clock on week-ends.
- (b) No boy or girl on the Kincolith Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age or Grade 7 down shall be in any place of entertainment, street, lane, by-way, or common, within the said Reserve, or shall be returning from any place of entertainment of the said Reserve after the hour of of eight o'clock on week days, and nine o'clock in the afternoon on weekends, unless accompanied by his/her parent, or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany such child, or a written consent approving their whereabouts, and that all High School Students from Grade 8, to 12, have to be off the streets by 12 o'clock midnight.
- (c) No boy or girl on the Kincolith Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years and/or going to High School shall disturb the "Peace by carelessly" blasting away at his/her musical stereo equipment after midnight, or the said equipment shall be confiscated.



- (d) A boy or girl on the Kincolith Indian Reserve found violating the provisions of paragraph (a), (b), or (c) may be warned and conducted home by a police officer, and if the warning is not regarded or after the warning, the boy or girl is again found disobeying the said paragraph (a), (b), or (c) the parents of such boy or girl shall be directed to meet with the Band Council, for the protection of the children.
- (e) A parent who permits his/her child to violate paragraph (a), (b), or (c) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$25.00 or that child should have his/her special privelages taken away for a certain length of time, depending on circumstances.
