The Gouncil of the Kispiax Band of Indians at a meeting held at the Indian Office on 11th May 1953 make the fellowing bylaw pursuant to peragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

## bylav He. 1

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in Kispick Indian Reserve, in the Prevince of British Columbia.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band,
- (b) He wehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the Kispiox Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the Council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the previsions of this bylaw shall be guilty of ah effence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
