Bylaw No. 5

A hylaw to provide for the licencing of businesses, callings, trades and occupations within the KITKATLA Indian Reserve, in the Province of BRITISH CELUMBIA.

- (a) No person shall conduct or carry on any business, calling, trade or occupation as listed herein who is not the holder of a valid and subsisting licence for the business, calling, trade or occupation issued pursuant to this bylaw.
- (b) There shall be paid at the time of the application for a licence a fee in the amount as set out hereunder, which licence may be renewed from year to year upon payment of the required fee.
