The Council of the <u>Kitseaukla</u> Band of Indians at at meeting held this <u>Is</u> day of <u>September</u> 1972, make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and paragraph (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

B;-low to. 1-73

A oy-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the <u>Mitserukla</u> Indian deserve, in the province of <u>British Columbia</u>.

1. In this by-law

(a) "Council means the Council of the Kithagakla Band of Indians;

(b) "Reserve" means the <u>Kitsegukla</u> Indian Reserve;

(c) "Residential area" means any area in the Reserve designated in writing by the Council as a residential area for the ourpose of this by-law:and

- (d) "vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor car, motor truckm, trailer, motorcycle, traction engine, tractor, read-making machinery or other conveyance that is driven, propelled or drawn by any kind of power.
- 2. No vehicle shall be operated on the Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 hereof, no vahicle shall be operated in any residential area at a rate of speed in excess of <u>20</u> miles an hour.
- 4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guily of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
