The Council of the <u>Hartley Bay</u> Band of Indians at a meeting held <u>January 10th</u>, 1956 at <u>Prince Rupert</u>, B.C. makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (h) and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

Bylaw No. 9

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of the construction and repair of buildings whether owned by the band or by individual members of the band.

- (a) No person shall construct any building within the limits of Kulkayu #4A Indian Reserve until permission therefore has been granted under the authority of a resolution of the council.
- (b) No person shall make or undertake any repair of any building within the limits of the reserve until permission therefore has been granted under the authority of a resolution of the council, provided, however, that no such permission shall be required in the case of the making or undertaking of repairs of a minor nature not exceeding in value the amount of 50.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary
 conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment
 for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
