The Council of the Hazelton Band at a meeting held 1/22/1/6/ March 22 1961 makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraphs (f) and (r) of section 80 and paragraphs (f) and (g) of sub-section (1) of section 82 of the Indian Act.

## By-law No. 2

- A by-law to provide for the maintenance of a water system within the Hazelton Indian Reserve No. 1 in the Province of British Columbia and provision of a tax.
- (a) The Hazelton Band Waterworks System shall be under the control of the Hazelton Band Council, which has passed the attached regulations for the control and management of the said waterworks system and which regulations form part of this by-law and shall be in effect from the date of the passing of this by-law, a copy of which regulations is duly recorded in the office of the Indian Superintendent.
- (b) In addition to the penalties provided in the said regulations, any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

## SCHEDULE OF FEES

## HAZELTON BAND WATERWORKS SYSTEM

- 1. Every user shall pay a water rate of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per month into the funds of the Hazelton Band, and this shall include any person who, not having water taken into his own premises, draws it from the premises of one who has.
- 2. The Bailiff shall be paid in consideration of the performance of all his duties 15% of the total rates collected from the funds of the Hazelton Band.
