

VICIOUS ANIMALS

10. For the purpose of this by-law any animal that attacks or bites a person shall be classed as having a vicious temperament.
- (1) The Constable will immediately seize and may destroy the animal.
 - (2) The animal for rabies control purpose may be quarantined for a period of ten (10) days. The animal will not be released except with the approval of a medical health officer.
 - (3) The owner may redeem his animal after approval of the medical officer, and all cost incurred throughout these proceedings are paid by the owner.
11. No owner of an animal shall permit such an animal to run at large, within the LIARD INDIAN BAND Reserve Lands.
12. An owner of a dog who refuses or neglects the contents of a written notice within the period of 5 days shall be guilty of a breach of this by-law.
13. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable to a summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$ 25⁰⁰ or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 days or both fine and imprisonment.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the LIARD INDIAN Band of Indians this 4th day of FEBRUARY 19 86.

The quorum for this Band consists of the Chief and 3 Council members.
