

FIREARM BY-LAW

Council of the Swan Lake Band of Indians at a meeting held 22 day of August, 1977 hereby enacts by-law No. 6-77 to provide for the regulation of firearms within the boundaries of Swan Lake Indian Reserve.

Whereas: paragraphs (c) (d) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act empowers the Council of a Band to make by-laws respecting the observance of law and order, the prevention of disorderly conduct and the imposition of a penalty for the violation thereof; and

Whereas; it is deemed to be expedient to limit the manner of usage and exposing of firearms on the reserve for the safety and welfare of inhabitants of the Swan Lake Indian Reserve.

Now therefore the Council of the Swan Lake Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following:

1. In this by-law,
 - (a) "Council means the Council as defined in the Indian Act of the Swan Lake Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Reserve" means the tract of land set apart by Her Majesty within the definition of the Indian Act, for the use and benefit of the Swan Lake Band of Indians known as the Swan Lake Reserve.
 - (c) "Firearm" means any make or calibre of rifle, shotgun, pistol, handgun, and in this by-law shall include air guns, BB guns, pellet guns and cross bows.
 - (d) "Vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor car, motor truck, trailer, motorcycle, tractor or other conveyance that is driven, propelled or drawn by any kind of power.
2. No person shall carry a firearm concealed in his/her attire within the boundaries of the Swan Lake Indian Reserve.
3. All firearms carried in a vehicle within the Swan Lake Reserve shall be kept inconspicuous at all times and in such a place and manner that no person will have immediate access.
4. No person shall upon any street, road, or inhabited area within the Swan Lake Reserve discharge or attempt to discharge a firearm.
5. No person shall on the Swan Lake Indian Reserve actually or apparently under 16 years of age have in their possession or be allowed to handle or discharge or attempt to discharge a firearm without adult supervision.
6. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment.
7. A parent or guardian who permits his/her child or ward to violate Section 5 of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a summary conviction pursuant to Section 6 of this by-law.
