

BYLAW

SOP/85-874

WHEREAS THE SHAMATTAWA BAND COUNCIL CONSIDERS IT NECESSARY TO PROVIDE,
BYLAW PURSUANT TO SECTION 85.1 OF THE INDIAN ACT, FOR REGULATING
THE PRESENCE AND USE OF INTOXICANTS ON THE RESERVES OF THE SHAMATTAWA
BAND;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ENACTED THAT:

DEFINITIONS

1. IN THIS BYLAW,

(A) "BAND MEANS THE SHAMATTAWA INDIAN BAND;

(B) "RESERVE" MEANS THE RESERVE OR ALL OF THE RESERVES SET ASIDE FROM
TIME TO TIME FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE BAND, BUT DOES NOT
INCLUDE ANY SPECIAL RESERVE;

(C) "BAND MEMBER" MEANS A MEMBER OF THE BAND;

(D) "INTOXICANT" MEANS ANY INTOXICATING SUBSTANCE WHICH IS CAPABLE OF
HUMAN CONSUMPTION AND CONTAINS EITHER MORE THAN 1% BY WEIGHT OR MORE
THAN 1% BY VOLUME OF ALCOHOL OR ALCOHOLS.

PROHIBITIONS

1. ANY PERSON WHO IS INTOXICATED ON THE RESERVE IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENSE
AND IS LIABLE ON SUMMARY CONVICTION TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE
HUNDRED DOLLARS OR TO IMPRISONMENT FOR A TERM NOT EXCEEDING THREE MONTHS
OR TO BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.

2. THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO EFFECT ON AUGUST 19, 1985.

BYLAW

DEFINITIONS

1. IN THIS BYLAW,

(A) "BAND" MEANS THE SHAMATTAWA INDIAN BAND;

(B) "RESERVE" MEANS THE RESERVE OR ALL OF THE RESERVES SET ASIDE FROM TIME TO TIME FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE BAND, BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY SPECIAL RESERVE;

(C) "BAND MEMBER" MEANS A MEMBER OF THE BAND;

(D) "INTOXICANT" MEANS ANY INTOXICATING SUBSTANCE WHICH IS CAPABLE OF HUMAN CONSUMPTION AND CONTAINS EITHER MORE THAN 1% BY WEIGHT OR MORE THAN 1% BY VOLUME OF ALCOHOL OR ALCOHOLS.

PROHIBITIONS

1. ANY PERSON WHO IS INTOXICATED ON THE RESERVE IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENSE AND IS LIABLE ON SUMMARY CONVICTION TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OR TO IMPRISONMENT FOR A TERM NOT EXCEEDING THREE MONTHS OR TO BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.

2. THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO EFFECT ON AUGUST 19, 1985.
