and

Whereas; the Sandy Bay Band Council is of the opinion that the said by-law is ineffective and is not required at this time,

Now therefore; the Council of the Sandy Bay Band of Indians enacts as a by-law there of the following;

By law Number 2-R-77 enacted and being a by-law to repeal by-law number 2 effecting cattle and domestic animals on the Sandy Bay Indian Reserve and enacted on October 14, 1977 is hereby approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Sandy Bay Band of Indians this 14th day of October, 1977.
