



BEE KEEPING BY-LAW

The Council of the Long Plain Band of Indians at a meeting held this 22 day of August 1977 hereby enacts by-law number 15-77 to provide for the regulation of Bee keeping within the boundaries of the Long Plain Indian Reserve in the Province of Manitoba.

Whereas paragraphs (k) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act empowers the Council of a Band to provide for the regulation of beekeeping and the imposition of a penalty for a violation thereof, and

Whereas it is deemed to be expedient to control the activities of beekeepers for the welfare and safety of the inhabitants of the Long Plain Indian Reserve.

Now therefore the Council of the Long Plain Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following:

1. In this by-law,
 - (a) "Council" means the Council as defined in the Indian Act of the Long Plain Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Reserve" means the tract of land set apart by Her Majesty within the definition of the Indian Act, for the use and benefit of the Long Plain Band of Indians known as the Long Plain Reserve.
 - (c) "Hives" means bee hives.
2. No person shall place or cause to be placed hives upon the Reserve without the written consent of the Chief and Council.
3. No person shall place or cause to be placed hives near a dwelling house without the occupants permission either expressed or implied.
4. No person shall without lawful excuse, the proof of which lies upon him, prowl or loiter by day or by night upon the site where hives are located.
5. The Band Council shall authorize the owner of hives to place and maintain or cause to be placed or maintained warning signs indicating the distance and location of hives.
6. No person shall interfere with or attempt to interfere with by removing, defacing, obliterating or altering any authorized bee signs within the Long Plain Indian Reserve.
7. No person shall molest or destroy or attempt to molest hives within the Long Plain Indian Reserve.
8. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Long Plain Band of Indians this 22 day of August 1977.
