DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

That we make the following By-law pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 1:

A By-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Little Saskatchewan Indian Reserve, in the Province of Manitoba.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour on any road within the Little Saskatchewan Indian Reserve.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (a), no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles per hour within any school area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
