The God's Lake Band of Indians

By Law 3

Being a by-law to repeal by-law number 1 dated February 16, 1961, providing for the regulation of the activities of all boys and girls on the God's Lake Indian Reserve who are age sixteen or under.

WHEREAS the Council of the God's Lake Band of Indians did enact by-law number 1 on the 16th day of February, 1961 pursuant to paragraphs (c), (d), (q) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act to regulate the activities of boys and girls on the God's Lake Indian Reserve who were of the age sixteen or under;

AND WHEREAS the said Council is of the opinion that such a by-law is not required at this time;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the God's Lake Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following:

1. By-law number 1 enacted on the 16th day of February, 1961 and being a by-law to regulate the activities of boys and girls on the God's Lake Indian Reserve who are of the age of sixteen or under is hereby repealed.
