The Council of the Ebb & Flow Band of Indians at a Meeting held this

Fourteenth day of October , 1964, make the following By-Law

pursuant to paragraph (b) and paragraph (c) of Section 80 of The Indian

Act.

BY-LAW NO. 2

A By-law to provide for the placement and maintenance of traffic signs on roads lying within Ebb & Flow Indian Reserve No. 52.

- 1. In this By-law
 - (a) "Council" means the Council of the Ebb & Flow Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Road" includes any roadway, driveway, street, lane or other place open to the public for the passage of vehicles;
 - (c) "Traffic Engineer" means a person appointed by the Council to place and maintain traffic signs; and
 - (d) "Traffic sign" includes a sign, warning, marking or other device for the guidance or direction of per sons using the roads.
- 2. The design and dimension of traffic signs shall be approved by the Council.
- 3. (1) No traffic sign shall be placed on any road unless authorized by a Resolution passed by the Council.
 - (2) The Resolution of the Council shall specify the location where a traffic sign is to be placed.
- 4. The traffic engineer shall place and maintain the traffic signs authore ized by the Council.
- 5. No person shall interfere withor attempt to interfere with the traffic engineer in the placement or maintenance of any traffic sign.
- 6. No person shall remove, deface, obliterate, alter or attempt to remove, deface, obliterate or alter, or in any manner interfere with any traffic sign lawfully placed on a road.

7. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days or both fine and imprisonment.
