DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE BY-LAW

2 Council of the Oak Lake Band of Indians at a meeting held this 22nd day of August hereby enacts by-law member 1-77 to provide for the regulation of the disposal of garbage and waste within the boundaries of the Oak Lake Indian Reserve.

Whereas paragraph (a) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act empowers the Council of a Band to make by-laws to provide for the health of residents on the Reserve and to prevent the spreading of contagious and infections diseases and the imposition of a penalty for a violation thereof, and,

Whereas it is deemed to be expedient to control the disposal of garbage and waste for the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Oak Lake Indian Reserve.

Now therefore the Council of the Oak Lake Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof the following:

- 1. In this by-law,
 - (a) "Council" means the Council as defined in the Indian Act of the Oak Lake Band of Indians;
 - (b) "Reserve" means the tract of almd set apart by Her Majesty within the definition of the Indian Act, for the use and benefit of the Oak Lake Band of Indians known as teh Oak Lake Reserve.
 - (c) "Premises" means land and residences within the Reserve.
- 2. No person shall accumulate or permit to be accumulated upon premises in his possession or deposit or accumulate on premises in possession of another person anything which is or may become offensive or injurious to health.
- 3. No person shall deposit any dead animal, offal fish, manure, garbage, fruit, vegetables, night soil, filth, liquid waste, human excretion, or anything of a nature which is or may become offensive or prejudicial to health upon or into any highway, street, road, alley, lane, lot, ditch, wharf, dock, pond, river, stream, well, or sewer or into and premises within the Reserve and any such deposit shall be deemed a nuisance, provided, however, that the provision of this paragraph shall not apply to the deposit and proper disposal of any such waste and material into or at a place within the Reserve approved by the Council for that purpose.
- 4. The Council may arrange for a regular removal of garbage and waste from any premises within the Reserve.
- 5. In the spring of each year, as soon as the melting of snow permits the person residing in any premises within the reserve shall collect all waste matter lying thereon including tin cans, bottles, paper and animal manure.
- 6. All such waste matter shall be disposed of in such a manner as will prevent any nuisance or offence as the fouling or polluting of wells and wa water supply.
- 7. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on a summary conviction of a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment.
