

THE OAK LAKE BAND OF INDIANS.
BY-LAW NO. 1

Being a by-law to establish Administrative
and Financial Regulations

WHEREAS the Council of the Oak Lake Band of Indians has agreed to administer, manage, and put into effect certain projects and programs for the benefit and well being of the members of the Band of Indians;

AND WHEREAS the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development has agreed, pursuant to their program generally known as "Grants to Bands", to turn over to the Council of the Oak Lake Band of Indians certain funds for the purpose of underwriting part or all of the costs of the said programs and projects;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient and in the best interests of the members of the Oak Lake Band of Indians to ensure that the programs and projects are administered, and the funds are expended in an efficient manner;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Oak Lake Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof, pursuant to Section 80(q) of the Indian Act, the following:

1. The Administrative and Financial Regulations dated 1971, attached hereto and marked Appendix 'A' (which regulations are deemed to be and form part of this by-law) be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.

2. These Regulations shall come into force and take effect
on the 6th day of April, 1971.
