DO HEREBY RESOLVE: and make the following By-law pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 2.

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Fisher River Indian Reserve in the Province of Manitoba.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 45 miles per hour on any road, not classified as a Provincial road, within the Fisher River Indian Reserve.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles per hour within any school or community hall area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
