INTOXICANT BY-LAW

Whereas a majority of the electors of the Bloodvein First Nation voted on the referendum of the Bloodvein First Nation on February 1, 1990 called by the Council of the Bloodvein First Nation for the purpose of considering the contents of this by-law, consented to the contents of this by-law.

And, whereas the Bloodvein First Nation Council consider necessary special measures for the protection of the inhabitants of the reserves) of the Bloodvein First Nation from the presence of the intoxicants.

Now therefore, it is hereby enacted pursuant to section 85.1 of the Indian Act.

Definitions

1. In this By-Law:

"Intoxicants" includes alcohol, alcoholic, spiritous, vinous, fermented malt or other intoxicating liquor or combination of liquors and mixed liquor: a part of which is spiritous, vinous, fermented or otherwise intoxicating and all drinks or drinkable liquids and all preparations or mixtures capable of human consumption that are intoxicating.

Prohibition of Sale, Barter, Supply or Manufacture

2. Anyone who sells, barters, supplies or manufactures intoxicants on the reserves) of the Bloodvein First Nation is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction.

Prohibition against Intoxication

3. Anyone who is intoxicated causing a disturbance anywhere, and in possession of an intoxicant is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction.

Prohibition on possession of Intoxicants

4. Anyone who is found in possession of an unreasonable amount of intoxicants is guilty of an offence punishable on Summary conviction.

Penalties

5. For greater certainty, the penalties for contravention of this by-law are set out in the Indian Act.

Citation

6. This by-law may be cited as By-law No. 1290 of the Bloodvein First Nation being a by-law respecting Intoxicants.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Bloodvein First Nation this 6th day of February, 1990.

Whereas: that on the 1st day of February 1990 A.D. at a secret ballot election held to obtain their assent to an Intoxicant By-law, there were 142 community members in attendance of whom 100 assented to the Intoxicant By-law and 42 dissapproved; and

Whereas: the Bloodvein First Nation Council has met and considered the Intoxicant By-law; and

Therefore: be it resolved that the Bloodvein First Nation Band Council hereby adopts and approves the Intoxicant By-law of the Bloodvien First Nation #267 as assented to by a majority of the community members present.
