THAT WE THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF ST. MARY'S BAND PASS THIS DATE THE FOLLOWING BY-LAW UNDER SECTION 81, SUBSECTION (E IN PART) A BY-LAW.

- Not permitting the keeping of domestic animals on the Reserve particularly the residential area and in particular cattle, goats, horses, sheep, mules, chickens, turkey or any farm baring animal
- 2. Unless properly zoned all areas shall be classed as residential
- Fine shall dispose of any such animal found in any area unless otherwise classed as farm or commercial areas within Reserve boundaries now 3. properly marked
- Failing to comply with paragraph 3 will result in the following: (A) fine of \$50.00 4.

 - fine of \$50.00 plus destruction of animals (B)
 - \$50.00 fine, destruction of animals or imprisonment of five days.
